- Goldfish have been kept as pets for over 2000 years! Pet goldfish date all the way back to ancient China!
- Domestic goldfish were introduced to Japan in 1603, to Europe in 1611 and to North America around 1850.
- 3. A group of goldfish is "a troubling". Just as you'd say "a herd of cows", you'd say "a troubling of goldfish"!
- 4. Goldfish can live for decades! Some goldfish have been known to live for over 40 years!
- Goldfish can grow to over a foot long when kept in the right conditions
- Goldfish need a big tank, not a bowl! We recommend 20 gallons (90L) for one fancy goldfish and 30 gallons (135L) for one common/comet goldfish.
- 7. Goldfish have a memory-span of at least three months!

 The 3 second memory is a myth!
- 8. Goldfish will eat plants, insects, small crustaceans, and sometimes even other small fish!
- Goldfish have teeth! But they're not like human teeth.Goldfish teeth are near the back of their throats.
- 10. Goldfish don't have stomachs! Goldfish should therefore be fed easily digestible food in lots of small feeding sessions, rather than lots of food at once.
- 11. Goldfish have no eyelids, so they sleep with their eyes open!
- 12. Goldfish can see more colors than humans can! Goldfish are able to see ultra-violet and infra-red light.
- 13. Goldfish lay lots of eggs! A female goldfish will lay hundreds or even thousands of eggs in a single spawning.
